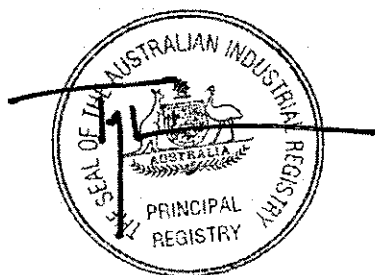




4. Collieries' Staff Division
