We wish to advise that elections for regional representation in this organization are due to be held this year and, to this end, enclose the prescribed information relating to the elections in accordance with the Act.

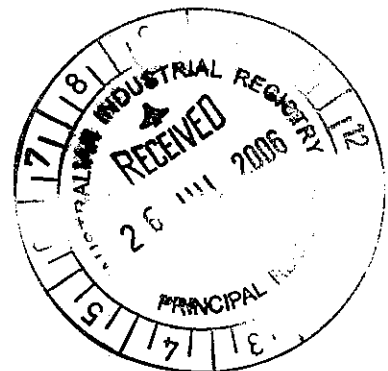
