

In accordance with subsection 189(1) of Schedule 1 of the the Workplace Relations Act 1996 [the RAO Schedule], I wish to advise the Regstrar of the need to conduct an election for Federal Officers of the Australasian Meat Industry Employees' Union.

In accordance with Regulation 138 of the Workplace Regulations (Registration and Accountability of Organisations) Regulations 2003, I am providing the following prescribed information:

(a) The name of each office or position for which an election is required:-

Federal Secretary/Treasurer Federal President Federal Vice-President

- (b) The reason for the election is that the term of office of these officers will expire at the 2008 Federal Council meeting of the organisation, which is to be held in Townsville on 8-11 September 2008. It is proposed that the election be conducted on 11 September 2008.
- (c) The offices referred to above are singular offices. There is to be one Federal Secretary/Treasurer elected, one Federal President elected, and one Federal Vice-President elected.
- (d) The electorate for both of the offices is the Federal Council of the AMIEU. A current copy all of all such members of the Federal Council is attached.

(e) There is an ambiguity in the rules of the AMIEU as to the relevant opening and closing of nominations. No opening day of nominations is stipulated at all. Rule 17.8 suggests that nominations may be taken at the Federal Council meeting. Rule 17.9 suggests that nominations must be forwarded in writing no later than two weeks prior to the scheduled meeting.

The AMIEU therefore proposes the following timetable to avoid any difficulties:-

Opening of nominations: Immediately.

Closing of nominations: 28 August 2008 [two weeks prior to 11 September].

- (f) There is no closing date for the roll of voters. The Federal Council is a static body elected effectively with each quadrennial Branch election. As such, the need for a closing date for a roll of voters is unnecessary.
- (g) The kind of voting system to be used in the conduct of the election is a collegiate voting system.

This information is lodged under s.189(1) of the RAO Schedule. I certify that I am an officer of the organisation authorised to provide this information.

I request that you make arrangements for the election to be held.
