Reminder of actions required when persons elected to office

The Australian Electoral Commission has provided the Registered Organisations Commission (the ROC) a declaration of results for the election of uncontested and contested offices for South Australia & West Australia Branch [E2017/120]. This letter is a reminder of certain obligations imposed on organisations and on persons elected to office.

A notice must be published on the organisation's website

The organisation or branch must publish on its website a notice that a copy of the report is available from the organisation, branch or the AEC on request. The notice must be kept on the website for a period of at least 3 months (see regulation 141 of the Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Regulations 2009).

Holders of office required to undertake approved training

Section 293K of the *Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Act 2009* (the RO Act) requires each officer with financial management duties to undertake approved training that covers those duties within 6 months after the person begins to hold office. Please ensure that relevant officers undertake approved training within the required timeframe. Please also ensure that all new holders of office are advised of their obligations to make disclosures regarding remuneration, non-cash benefits and material personal interests, the details of which are provided for in the RO Act.

Organisation must notify the Commission of changes

Also, section 233(2) of the RO Act requires that an organisation must notify the Commission within 35 days of any changes to the holders of office in the organisation. If there are no changes a notification is not required. If the election has resulted in any changes to the holders of office, the Australasian Meat Industry Employees Union, The-SA & WA Branch must notify the Commission of these changes. In particular, please advise:

- 1. Person(s) who have ceased to hold office:
 - the name of the office vacated;
 - the date of the change of office holder; and
 - the name of the person vacating the office.
- 2. Person(s) who have commenced to hold office:
 - the name of the office now held;
 - the date of the change of office holder;
 - the name of the person now holding the office;

- the postal address of the person (generally the postal address of the organisation); and
- the occupation of the person now holding the office.

The notification must include a declaration by the Secretary (or other prescribed officer) that the information is a correct statement of the changes made. A template notification of changes, which may assist you, is attached. If any change does not apply until a date in the future, you do not need to notify until then (e.g. AGM, 1 January, 2nd Monday in March). If you have already lodged this information, please disregard this reminder.

AMIEU South & Western Australian Branch Elections:

I refer to the following resolution of the AMIEU South & Western Australian Branch executive meeting made on the 11th March 2017:

MOTION:

1. "That the Committee of Management directs the Branch Secretary to call on the 2017 Quadrennial Elections in accordance with rule 50"

Moved: Mark Hatcher Seconded: Greg Mitchell

CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY

Pursuant to s.189(1) of the Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Act 2009 I request that South & Western Australian Branch elections be conducted before 31st August 2017 and provide the following prescribed information:

- (a) The name of each office or position for which an election is required:
- 47A.9 For the 2017 quadrennial elections and onwards, the Committee of Management of the South and Western Australian Branch shall consist of a President, a South Australian Vice President, a Western Australian Vice President, a Secretary- Treasurer, an Assistant Secretary, Organisers and the following representatives:
 - 47A.9.1 Four (4) representatives from South Australia;
 - 47A.9.2 Four (4) representatives from Western Australia;
- 47A.10 Members of the Committee of Management shall be elected as follows:
 - 47A.10.1 The Branch President, Branch Secretary, and Assistant Branch Secretary shall be elected by all the members within the Branch.
 - 47A.10.2 The South Australian Vice President shall be elected from members in South Australia.
 - 47A.10.3 The Western Australian Vice President shall be elected from members in Western Australia.

47A.10.4 Prior to each quadrennial election, the Committee of Management must determine the number of organisers to be elected from South Australia and the number of organisers to be elected from Western Australia. Organisers shall then be elected by the members from the State they will represent.

I refer to the following resolution of the AMIEU South & Western Australian Branch committee of management meeting made on the 11th March 2017:

MOTION:

"That the Committee of Management determines that the officers for the election shall be those listed in Rule 47A10. The number of organisers for elections within South Australia shall be 3, number of organisers in Western Australia shall be 0"

CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY

| 47A.10.5 | The other representatives on the Committee of Management shall be elected by the members in the State they represent. |

| 47A.10.6 | The Secretary of the South and Western Australian Branch shall be based in Adelaide, and until such time as the Committee of Management determines otherwise, the Assistant Secretary of the South and Western Australian Branch shall be based in Perth. |

Four (4) delegates to Federal Council as prescribed by Rule 13.2.3 of the AMIEU Rules.

(b) The reason for the election is that the term of the office or position is due to expire in the normal course of events under the rules of the organisation.

(c) There are no offices or positions to be determined before the prescribed day.

(d) The electorate comprises only eligible members of the South and Western Australian Branch of the Australasian Meat Industry Employees Union.

(e) Pursuant to Rule 50.1 Branch elections can be held during 2017 not later than the thirty-first day of December 2017. Nominations shall be called for at least fourteen (14) days before the advertised date of closing of nominations. The close of the ballot shall be thirty-five (35) days after the date set for the closing of nominations.

(f) Rule 10.1 provides for the roll of voters to be closed 30 days before the date fixed for the opening of nominations.

(g) The election is to be conducted as a direct voting system.
