Dear Sir,

I advise that a casual vacancy exists pursuant to the Rules of the Australasian Meat Industry Employees' Union at Clause 51 – Casual Vacancies (Branch Officers).

In accordance with subsection 189 (1) of the Workplace Relations Act Schedule 1B Registration and Accountability of Organisations (RAO) and prescribed information in respect of RAO Regulation 138 I provide the following information.

(1) (a) The name of each office or position for which an election is required;

- (b) Reason for the election is that:

- (g) The kind of voting system to be used in the conduct of the election 151567
 - (a) a direct voting system



- (2) I have attached a statement signed by me, as Secretary of the Australasian Meat Industry Employees Union Newcastle and Northern Branch, duly authorised to sign the statement. The information is lodged under subsection 189 (1) of the RAO Schedule.
- (3) The prescribed information is lodged pursuant to subsection 189 (2) of the RAO Schedule. The prescribed day being at least 2 months before a person may under the rules become a candidate in the election.

Please be advised that the Newcastle and Northern Branch of the Australasian Meat Industry Employees Union has also applied to the New South Wales Industrial Registrar to conduct the election to fill the casual vacancy for the position of Committee of Management Member of the State Registered Union. It would be appreciated if the election of Committee of Management Member to fill the casual vacancy pursuant to subsection 189 of the RAO Schedule could be held simultaneously with the election of fill the casual vacancy pursuant to the New South Wales Industrial Relations Act 1996.

I request that you make arrangements for the election to fill the casual vacancy be held as soon as possible.

Section 197(1) of Schedule 1 of the Workplace Relations Act 1996 requires the AEC to provide a written report on the conduct of the election to the Industrial Registrar and to the organisation or branch for whom the election was conducted. If a website is not available, publishing a notice in a journal or newsletter would be considered appropriate.
