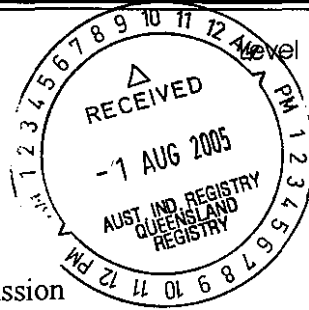

The elections for the Australasian Meat Industry Employees' Union, Queensland Branch are due. In accordance with subsection 189(1) of the *Workplace Relations Act 1996 [Schedule 1B Registration and Accountability of Organisations]* ("RAO") and prescribed information in respect of RAO Regulation 138, I provide the following information:-

(b) The reason for the election is that the term of the office or position referred to above has expired or is due to expire in the normal course of events under the Rules of the organisation.

(c) The amount of organisers that are to be elected was determined by resolution of Queensland Branch Committee of Management on 12 August 2002 pursuant to rule 47.18.

(d) The electorate for the Queensland Branch Officer positions are the whole of the membership of Queensland Branch of the Union. The electorate for the regional positions under rule 47.14 is comprised of those members residing in the boundaries of the regions specified in rule 47.16.

(e) Rule 50.1 Branch Elections, provides that the Branch Elections are to be held not later than the thirty first day of December 1969 and shall be conducted on every four years. An election must be held not later than 31 December 2005. The date for the opening and closing of nominations is at the returning officer's determination under rule 50.9 (subject to the other requirements of that rule).

(f) Rule 50.7 provides that the Returning Officer shall compile a roll of members eligible to vote pursuant to Rule 10. Rule 10.1.1 provides that the half-year immediately preceding the half-year in which the ballot is conducted to be the date the roll is to be closed. Therefore, 30 June 2005 is the date the roll is to be closed.

(g) The kind of voting system to be used in the conduct of the election a direct voting system.

This information is lodged under s.189(1) of the RAO Schedule. I certify that I am authorised to provide this information.

I request that you make arrangements for the election to be held.

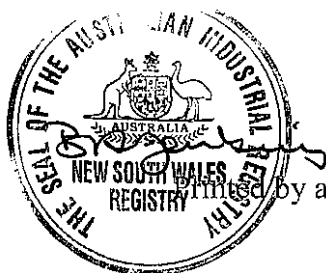
