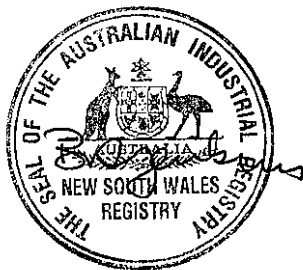
DECISION



 - (g) The nominations close at least 14 days after the nominations are advertised as determined by the returning Officer as per rule 50.8

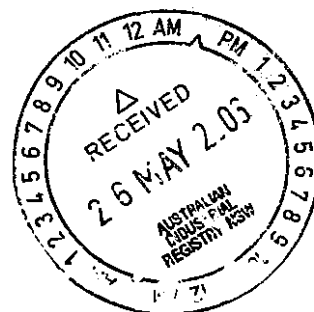
