Lodgment of Financial Statements and Accounts – The Australasian Meat Industry Employees Union, Tasmanian Branch - for years ended 30 June 2009 (FR2009/10071)

Thank you for lodging the abovementioned financial statements and accounts which were received by Fair Work Australia on 30 December 2009.

The documents have been filed. However I wish to draw your attention to several departures from the legislative requirements. In reviewing previous returns I notice that some or all have appeared in different years, and though not always having attracted my comment on each occasion, they should be corrected in future returns.

- (1) There was no "Statement of Changes in Equity" (or, in the alternative, a "Statement of Recognized Income and Expense") which is a statement required by AASB101, and consequently by s253(2)(a)(iv) of the Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Act 2009 (formerly the RAO Schedule).
- (2) The Notice "Information to be Provided to Members or Registrar" at Note 2 does not set out in full subsections (1), (2) and (3) as required by \$272(5) of the Act.
- (3) The Compilation Report signed by the Auditor refers to the report as a "special purpose financial report". This reference is incorrect for the purposes of lodgment under s253 of the Act (which requires that reports be general purpose financial reports), and appears inconsistent with the references elsewhere, such as in the Committee of Management Statement and in the Auditor's Report itself, to the report as a "general purpose financial report". If a Compilation Report is included it should be consistent with the Act and rest of the return.
- (4) The "Summary" was similar to summaries previously lodged, but does not comply with the "Concise Report" described in s265(3) of the Act. A Concise Report consists of the documents prescribed in regulation 161 of the Fair Work (Registered Organizations) Regulations 2009 (formerly the RAO Regulations). In particular, the summary was not endorsed by the Auditor as having been audited in accordance with the relevant Standards.

There is nothing preventing the Branch from preparing a summary in the form which it has in its reports to date, but if the Branch wishes to provide members with an abbreviated version of the report it must prepare a Concise Report and ensure it complies with all the provisions of s265(3) and regulation 161.




