Lodgment of Financial Accounts and Statements - Australasian Meat Industry Employees Union, Tasmanian Branch (FR2011/2710)

Thank you for lodging the above financial accounts and statements which were received by Fair Work Australia on 31 January 2012.

The documents have been filed. I would like to draw your attention however to the following.

The Operating Report indicates that the number of employees on a full time equivalent basis was 1. The Profit and Loss Statement indicates that Wages was \$123,357.71. It is not readily apparent whether this figure represents the wages for the employee(s) only or whether it also includes an amount for any office-holders. The Reporting Guidelines require separate balances for salaries to employees and salaries to office-holders.

I would ask that in future reports, the wages figure be more precisely described as either Employee Wages or Office-holder Wages as applicable.

NOTE: 1 STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES
The financial report to a general purpose financial report that has been prepared in accordance with Accounting Standards, Urgent Issues Group Consensus Views and other authoritative pronouncements of the Australian Accounting Standards Board and the Workplace Relations Act 1996.

The financial report has been prepared on an accruale basis and is based on historical costs, it does not take into account changing money values or except where stated, current valuations of non-current assets. Cost is based on the fair values of the consideration given in exchange for assets.

NOTE: 2 INCOME TAX

No provision for income tax has been raised as the Union is exempt from income tax under Division 50 of the Income Tax Assessment Act 1997.

NOTE: 4 INFORMATION TO BE PROVIDED TO MEMBERS OR REGISTRAR
