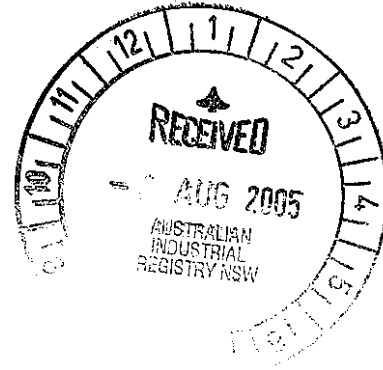

(c) The electorate for the Victorian Branch Offices is the whole of the membership of Victorian Branch of the Union. The electorate for the Committee of Management positions is comprised of:-

- (i) In the case "works" positions- those members employed at the particular establishments only; and
- (ii) In the case of geographical positions- those members residing in the boundaries of any areas specified in connection with the positions.

(d) Rule 50.1 Branch Elections, provides that the Branch Elections are to be held not later than the thirty first day of December 1969 and shall be conducted on every four years. An election must be held not later than 31 December 2005. The date for the opening and closing of nominations is at the returning officer's determination under rule 50.9 (subject to the other requirements of that rule).

(e) Rule 50.7 provides that the Returning Officer shall compile a roll of members eligible to vote pursuant to Rule 10. Rule 10.1.1 provides that the half-year immediately preceding the half-year in which the ballot is conducted to be the date the roll is to be closed. Therefore, 30 June 2005 is the date the roll is to be closed.


(f) The kind of voting system to be used in the conduct of the election a direct voting system.

This information is lodged under s.189(1) of the RAO Schedule. I certify that I am authorised to provide this information.



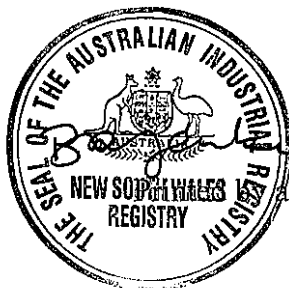
