AMIEU Victorian Branch Elections.

I refer to the following resolution of the AMIEU Victorian Branch Committee of Management made on the 20th June 2013:

1. *"THAT pursuant to Clause 50.1 of the AMIEU Rules the current terms of elected officers of the Victorian Branch are due to expire at 31st December 2013.*
2. *THAT the Victorian Branch Secretary apply in writing to the Fair Work Commission requesting that the Australian Electoral Commission conduct an election for all positions on the AMIEU Victorian Branch Committee of Management before 31st August 2013.*
3. *THAT four (4) Organisers be elected in addition to the President, Vice-President, Secretary-Treasurer, Assistant Secretary and industry representatives pursuant to the Rules."*

*MOVED: Robert Slimmon*

*SECONDED: Malcolm Dinsdale.*

Pursuant to s.189(1) of the Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Act 2009 I request that Victorian Branch elections be conducted before 31st August 2013 and provide the following prescribed information:

(a) The name of each office or position for which an election is required:

President, Vice-President, Secretary-Treasurer, Assistant Secretary, four (4) Organisers as decided by the Committee of Management.

As to the Metropolitan Area (for the purpose of this rule being an area extending to a 70 km radius of the GPO Melbourne) for the 2013 quadrennial Branch elections and onwards:

Six (6) representatives from Victorian supermarkets.

One (1) representative from each of the following works:

JBS Australia at Brooklyn

Colonial Farm

Diamond Valley Pork

Inghams Enterprises.

One (1) representative from the retail sector including works performing pre-packing for retail outlets.

As to outside the Melbourne metropolitan area for the 2013 quadrennial Branch elections and onwards:

One (1) representative from each of the following regional works:

M.C. Herd - Geelong  
Don KRC - Castlemaine  
CRF Foods (Victoria) Pty Ltd - Colac  
JBS Australia - Cobram  
Hardwicks - Kyneton  
Frewstal - Stawell  
Tabro Meat Exports - Lance Creek  
Ararat Abattoirs  
G.A. Gathercole - Wangaratta  
Riverside Meats/Bangarrang - Echuca

Two (2) delegates to Federal Council as prescribed by Rule 13.2.4 of the AMIEU Rules.

(b) The reason for the election is that the term of the office or position is due to expire in the normal course of events under the rules of the organisation.

(c) There are no offices or positions to be determined before the prescribed day.

(d) The electorate comprises only eligible members of the Victorian Branch of the Australasian Meat Industry Employees Union.

(e) Pursuant to Rule 50.1 Branch elections can be held during 2013 not later than the thirty-first day of December 2013. Nominations shall be called for at least fourteen (14) days before the advertised date of closing of nominations. The close of the ballot shall be thirty-five (35) days after the date set for the closing of nominations.

(f) Rule 10.1 provides for the roll of voters to be closed 30 days before the date fixed for the opening of nominations.

(g) The election is to be conducted as a direct voting system.
