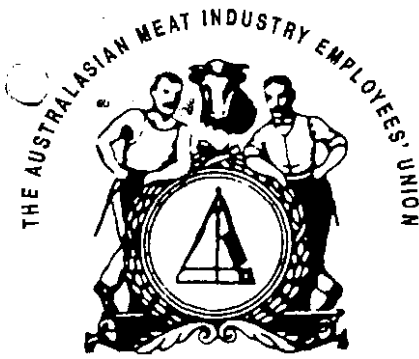

I, Graeme John Haynes, Acting West Australian Branch Secretary of the Australasian Meat Industry Employees' Union, make the following statement:


- *I am the Acting West Australian Branch Secretary of the Australasian Meat Industry Employees' Union,*

- *I confirm that the following information is being lodged under subsection 189(1) of the RAO Schedule.*

 - c) *the electorate comprises only members of the West Australian Branch*

- d) *the procedures in relation to opening and closing dates and declaration of result of the election are set out in Rule 50. It must be noted that the election must be conducted prior to the 31st December, 2005.*
- e) *the Rules require a direct voting system to be employed in the conduct of the election.*
