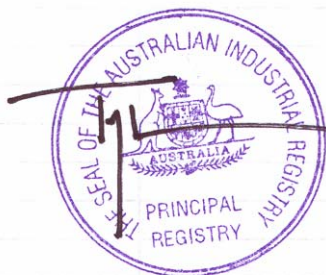
*Arrangement for conduct of election.*

**Arrangements for the conduct of an election in accordance with section 189 of Schedule 1 to the Workplace Relations Act 1996**

Pursuant to Section 189(1) of Schedule 1 to the *Workplace Relations Act 1996* ("Act") and Regulation 138 of the Workplace Relations (RAO) Regulations, I hereby lodge the following prescribed information concerning the 2007-2008 Committee of Management elections for the Australian and International Pilots Association (**AIPA**).

**Regulation 138(1)**

**(a) The name of each office in respect of which an election is required**

**20** Committee of Management members

**(b) The reason for the election**

- (i) With respect to **20** of the Committee of Management members, their term of office will expire (pursuant to Rule 40(a)(i) and Rule 56A) of AIPA's Rules.

**(c) The number of offices**

As set out in (a) above. The Committee of Management consists of forty (40) members. A half election is held each two years out of three to elect approximately twenty (20) members.

**(d) The electorate of each office**

The electorate for the Committee of Management positions is the total financial membership of AIPA.

**(e) The date and time of the commencement and expiration of the nomination period as set out in the rules of the organisation**

Nominations for the Committee of Management member positions are called on the 119<sup>th</sup> day before the second Tuesday in November each year, and for the current year the relevant date is **17 July 2007**. Nominations close at 1200 hours on or about the 98<sup>th</sup> day before the second Tuesday in November each year, and for the current year the relevant date is **7 August 2007** (Rule 38).

**(f) The day on which the roll of voters is to be closed**

The roll of voters closes on the 126<sup>th</sup> day before the second Tuesday in November each year and for the current year the relevant date was **10 July 2007** (pursuant to Rule 38(a)).


**(g) The voting system to be employed in the conduct of the election**

The voting system for Committee of Management positions will be a direct voting system. Elections are by secret postal ballot.

We look forward to receiving the Registrar's decision that an election for the abovenamed offices is required to be held under AIPA's Rules and advice that arrangements are being made for the conduct of the election by the Australian Electoral Commission.
