



Arrangement for conduct of election.

[1] On 30 April 2020 the Australian and International Pilots Association lodged with the Registered Organisations Commission prescribed information for an election to fill a casual vacancy in the following office for the remainder of the term:

[2] I am satisfied that an election for the abovenamed office is required to be held under the rules of the organisation and, under subsection 189(3) of the *Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Act 2009*, I am making arrangements for the conduct of the election by the Australian Electoral Commission.

PRESCRIBED INFORMATION FOR ELECTIONS in accordance with Section 189 Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Act 2009 and Regulation 138 Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Regulations 2009

I, Christopher Hewett, being the Secretary of the Australian and International Pilots Association make the following statement:

1. I am authorised to sign this statement containing prescribed information for the Australian and International Pilots Association.
2. The following information is lodged under subsection 189(1) of the Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Act 2009 (the RO Act).
3. The elections that are required are set out in the table in **Annexure A**.
4. The resignation letter or other supporting information is attached for each casual vacancy in **Annexure B**.
5. The casual vacancy created by the resignation of Tim Jarrold must be filled by an election in accordance rule 38(u)(i) of the AIPA Rules, as the unexpired part of the term of office exceeds three-quarters of the term of office.
6. No rule alterations are pending that will impact the election.
7. The AIPA Registered Rules do not specify a timeline by which elections called pursuant to Rule 38(u) of the Rules ought to be conducted. As such, it will be a matter for the Australian Electoral Commission's Returning Officer to determine the date and time of the commencement and expiration of the nomination period.
8. AIPA filed prescribed information on 18 March 2020 regarding 2 casual vacancies on the Committee of Management. On 28 April 2020, the ROC issued its decision E2020/70 for the arrangement for the election to fill these 2 casual vacancies on the AIPA Committee of Management. Noting that there is a delay to the conduct of elections generally due to the COVID-19 pandemic, we respectfully request that the elections for all 3 casual vacancies on the Committee of Management be run concurrently.
9. Accordingly, I am unable to confirm whether I have filed this statement 2 months before nominations open for the election below.

NOTE: A failure to lodge Prescribed Information on time can lead to civil penalties under the RO Act. Extensions of time should be requested at least two months before nominations open.
