



Arrangement for conduct of election.

[1] On 7 July 2020 the Australian and International Pilots Association lodged with the Registered Organisations Commission prescribed information for an election to fill the following offices:

[2] The organisation has previously submitted prescribed information in relation to filling a number of casual vacancies that have arisen on the Committee of Management – the body which comprises the electorate by and from which the above offices are to be elected. The Registered Organisations Commission has issued decisions to arrange for the conduct of elections to fill a total of five casual vacancies on the Committee of Management. These decisions are **E2020/70** dated 27 April 2020, **E2020/104** dated 1 June 2020 and **E2020/151** dated 6 August 2020.

[3] The organisation has appropriately requested that the election required to fill the casual vacancies set out in **E2020/70**, **E2020/104** and **E2020/151** should be conducted before the scheduled collegiate election in this matter (**E2020/83**). The basis for that request is that it would contribute to the democratic functioning of the organisation. Otherwise, one-eighth of the possible candidates and electorate will not be able to participate in the scheduled collegiate election.

[4] I am satisfied that an election for the abovenamed offices is required to be held under the rules of the organisation and, under subsection 189(3) of the *Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Act 2009*, I am making arrangements for the conduct of the election by the Australian Electoral Commission.

1. I am authorised to sign this statement containing prescribed information for the Australian and International Pilots Association.
2. The following information is lodged under subsection 189(1) of the Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Act 2009 (the RO Act).
3. The elections that are required are set out in the table in **Annexure A**.
4. This statement **IS** lodged at least 2 months before nominations open for the election below.
5. I note that there are currently zero Flight Engineer Members of AIPA as referenced in rule 20 and 21 and therefore no requirement to elect a Vice President (Flight Engineers).
6. We note that AIPA currently has four (4) casual vacancies on the Committee of Management (**CoM**). Accordingly, the electorate for the elections described in this prescribed will be in part determined by our Committee of Management Elections which will also take place this year. These elections have not commenced but were authorised on 27 April 2020 and 1 June 2020 in decisions 2020/70 and 2020/104 respectively. A third and separate prescribed information has been filed for the vacancy created by the resignation of CoM member Jarrod Bryce. We therefore respectfully request that these casual vacancies be filled prior to the conduct of the election provided for in **Annexure A**.
