



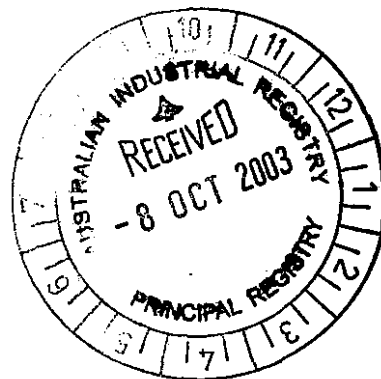

Reason for the Election

These elections are required to be held as a result of their being insufficient nominations received for these positions in the election processes recently held recently held. (E No 207 of 2003). Date and Times

Federal Rule 30 (2) states:

"Subject to the next sub-rule, the elections shall be conducted in accordance with a timetable which permits the declaration of the election on or before 31 October prior to the date on which the Federal Delegates assume office."

Federal Rule 73 and 74 are the relevant Rules for the election of the Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Education Committee members. The declaration of these elections must be on or before 30 November prior to the date the member takes office.

Electorate

The electorates for the elections for the National TAFE Council Delegate (NSW Branch) is the financial members assigned to the TAFE Division of the NSW Branch of the Union as at the close of nominations for the positions concerned.

In the case of the Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Education Committee members the electorates for the elections are the financial members assigned to the appropriate Division of the Branch as at the close of nominations for the positions (that is, General Division or TAFE Division), except that the members being nominated and the nominators must be Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander members.

Voting System

The voting system to be employed in the conduct of the elections for the offices is a direct voting system. In the case of the Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Federal Delegate and Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Education Committees the members being nominated and the nominators must be Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander members.

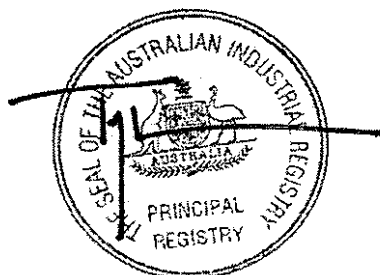
