Reason for the Election:

The terms of office of the above positions expires on 28 February, 2004. Those elected shall hold office for a two year term commencing 1 March 2004.

Date and Times:

Federal Rule 35 specifies the dates and times by which the elections for the above Federal Executive Member positions must be completed.

Provisions of the various Branch Rules specify the times and procedures to be followed in relation to the elections for these positions.

Electorate:

Rule 35(1)(d) states that the Executive Members representing the Branches as outlined above are "In all Branches other than the South Australian Branch and the Northern Territory Branch ... elected biennially by and from members of each Branch Council **who are assigned to the General Division**". In the case of the South Australian Branch and the Northern Territory Branch, Rule 35(1)(e) states that the Executive members are elected from the members of each Branch Executive **who are assigned to the General Division**




