Section 197(1) of Schedule 1 of the Workplace Relations Act 1996 requires the AEC to provide a written report on the conduct of the election to the Industrial Registrar and to the organisation or branch for whom the election was conducted. If a website is not available, publishing a notice in a journal or newsletter would be considered appropriate.

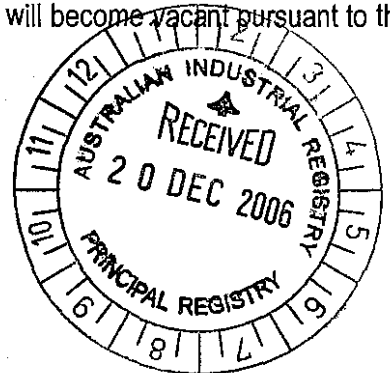
Australian Education Union (W.A. Branch) Elections

The terms of office for the Branch Officers and sixteen Branch Executive Members ceases on 28th February 2006.

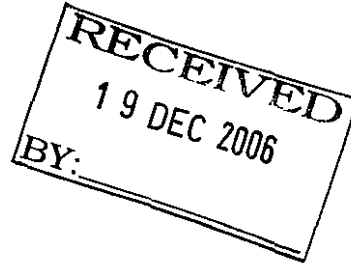
The electorates for the elections are:

The dates and times that nominations close are to be fixed by the Returning Officer pursuant to the Rules.


