Date and Times:

Federal Rule 35 specifies the dates and times by which the elections for the above Federal Executive Member positions must be completed.

Provisions of the various Branch Rules specify the times and procedures to be followed in relation to the elections for these positions.

Electorate:

Rule 35(1)(d) states that the Executive Members representing the Branches as outlined above are “In all Branches other than the South Australian Branch and the Northern Territory Branch ... elected biennially by and from members of each Branch Council **who are assigned to the General Division**”. In the case of the Northern Territory Branch, Rule 35(1) (e) states that the Federal Executive member(s) are elected from the members of the Branch Executive **who are assigned to the General Division**.

Membership lists of the Branch Councils and Branch Executive (in the case of the Northern Territory Branch) can be obtained from the relevant Branch Secretaries. It is important for the Returning Officer to ensure that the voting roll **excludes** any member of a Branch Council or Branch Executive who is a member of the TAFE Division of the Union.
