# DECISION

*Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Act 2009* s.189—Arrangement for conduct of an election

Arrangement for conduct of election.

[1] On 30 August 2017 the Australian Education Union (the union) lodged with the Registered Organisations Commission (the ROC) prescribed information for an election to fill the following offices:

Victorian Branch

Federal Conference Delegate representing the TAFE Division (1) National TAFE Council Delegate (1)

[2] On 6 April 2017 the union lodged prescribed information for various offices, including Federal Conference Delegates representing the TAFE Division from the Victorian Branch and National TAFE Council Delegates from the Victorian Branch. On 12 April 2017 I made arrangements for the election of these and other offices in E2017/55.<sup>1</sup>

[3] Federal Rule 24(2) provides that 'each Division in a Branch shall be entitled to one delegate for each 2,500 members assigned to each Division in the Branch or part thereof' as at 30 June of the relevant year. Federal Rule 24(3A) sets out a table that specifies the numbers.

[4] Federal Rule 47(3) provides the number of National TAFE Council Delegates and TAFE Council Executive Members shall be determined by the formula in the table in Federal Rule 47(3). The table states that the Number of Delegates shall be 2 for less than 500 members of the Division and then an additional Delegate for every 500 members or part thereof as at 30 June of the relevant year.

[5] At the time of making arrangements for an election in E2017/55 the number of Delegates to Federal Conference and National TAFE Council Delegate could not be ascertained. Consequently my decision stated that the numbers of offices to be elected were to be determined by the rules.

[6] On 5 July 2017 the union provided the relevant membership numbers to the ROC and Australian Electoral Commission (AEC). The membership numbers provided by the union entitled the Victorian Branch to one Federal Conference Delegate representing the TAFE Division and six National TAFE Council Delegates (one of which is ex-officio the Branch's National Council Executive Member). On 7 July 2017 the AEC commenced an election for a number of Victorian offices, including one Federal Conference Delegate representing the TAFE Division from the Victorian Branch and five National TAFE Council Delegates from the Victorian Branch.

[7] After the AEC commenced the election, the union discovered an error in the number of Victorian branch members in the TAFE Division that had been provided to the ROC and the AEC.

[8] On 13 September 2017 the Victorian Branch of the Australian Education Union provided the ROC with corrected information regarding the number of its members in the TAFE Division. The correct number entitles the Victorian Branch to one additional Federal Conference Delegate representing the TAFE Division and one additional National TAFE Council Delegate in accordance with Federal Rules 24(2), 24(3A) and 47(3).

**[9]** I am satisfied that an election for one additional Federal Conference Delegate representing the TAFE Division from the Victorian Branch and one additional National TAFE Council Delegate from the Victorian Branch is required to be held under the rules of the organisation and, under subsection 189(3) of the Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Act 2009, I am making arrangements for the conduct of the election by the Australian Electoral Commission.
