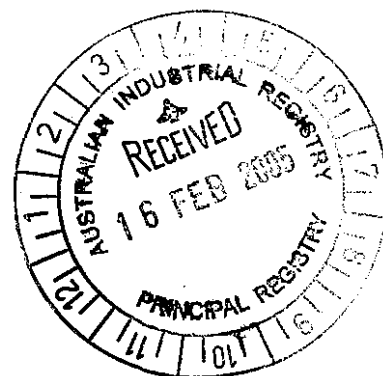



of the Workplace Relations Act 1996**

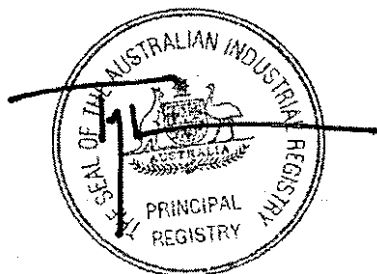
