- 1. I am the Secretary of the ACT Branch of the Australian Education Union, an organisation registered under the Fair Work [Registered Organisations] Act 2009. I am an authorised Officer to make requests for elections.
- 2. I hereby lodge with Fair Work Commission the prescribed information, as required under Regulation 138 of the Fair Work [Registered Organisations] Regulations 2009, for a request for elections to be conducted by the Australian Electoral Commission.
