Receipt is acknowledged of the financial documents of the above organisation for the financial year ended 31 December 2002. The documents were lodged in the Registry on 26 March 2003.

Having regard to the requirements of Part IX, Division 11, of the Workplace Relations Act and the Workplace Relations Regulations (the Regulations) the following matters require your further attention. Your written response to these matters is requested by 11 April 2003.

#### Income and Expenditure Statement.

Section 269(1) requires an organisation to lodge in the Industrial Registry as soon as possible after each financial year a statement showing the relevant particulars in relations to each loan, grant or donation of an amount exceeding \$1,000 made by the organisation during the financial year.

- Inspection of the income and expenditure statement discloses "Donations" and "Donation ACT TLC" of \$18,823 and \$77,625 respectively.
- Note 5 of the notes to the financial accounts for the year ended 31 December 2002 indicates that the branch has made loans totalling \$4,350.

Would you please arrange lodgement in the Industrial Registry of a section 269(1) statement covering any loan or donation exceeding \$1,000, and which sets out the particulars of each such loan or donation in accordance with subsections 269(4) and (5).

#### NOTES TO AND FORMING PART OF THE FINANCIAL STATEMENTS FOR THE YEAR ENDED 31 DECEMBER 2002

#### NOTE 1 - ACCOUNTING METHODS

The accounts are prepared under the historical cost convention and in accordance with the Accounting Standards jointly issued by the Australian Professional Bodies. In particular:

- (a) The accounts have not been adjusted to record either changes in the general purchasing power of money or in the value of specific assets.
- (b) Depreciation of fixed assets is calculated on the Prime Cost basis in order to write the assets off over their useful life.
- (c) Provision for employee benefits in the form of Long Service Leave and Accrued Annual Leave has been made for the estimated accrued entitlements of all employees on the basis of their employment.
- (d) No provision for income tax is necessary as "Trade Unions" are exempt from income tax under Section 23(f) of the Income Tax Assessment Act 1936.
- (e) Legal fees which have been committed but not yet billed have been brought to account and shown as a provision in the accounts.

#### NOTE 2 - INFORMATION TO BE PROVIDED TO MEMBERS OR REGISTRAR

In accordance with the requirements of the Workplace Relations Act 1996, as amended, the attention of members is drawn to the provisions of Sub-section (1) and (2) of Section 274, which reads as follows:

- (1) A member of an Organisation, or a Registrar, may apply to the Organisation for specified prescribed information in relation to the Organisation.
- (2) An Organisation shall, on application made under Sub-section (1) by a member of the Organisation, or a Registrar, make the specified information available to the member or Registrar in such manner, and within such time, as is prescribed.

#### PENALTY: \$ 1,000

(3) A Registrar may only make an application under Sub-section (1) at the request of a member of the Organisation concerned, and the Registrar shall provide to a member information received because of an application made at the request of the member.

#### **AUDITOR'S REPORT**

I have audited the accounts of the Australian Education Union, ACT Branch in respect of the year ended 31 December 2002 and have received all the information and explanations I required for the purposes of my audit.

#### Scope

The Executive Committee are responsible for the preparation and presentation of the financial reports and the information contained therein. I have conducted an independent audit of the financial reports in order to express an opinion on them to the members.

My audit has been conducted in accordance with Australian Auditing Standards to provide reasonable assurance as to whether the accounts are free of material misstatement. My procedures included examination, on a test basis, of evidence supporting the amounts and other disclosures in the accounts, and the evaluation of accounting policies and significant accounting estimates. These procedures have been undertaken to form an opinion as to whether, in all material respects, the accounts are presented fairly in accordance with Australian Accounting Concepts and Standards and Statutory Requirements so as to present a view of the Australian Education Union, ACT Branch which is consistent with my understanding of its financial position and the results of its operations.

The audit opinion expressed in this report has been formed on the above basis.

#### In my opinion:

- (i) there were kept by the Organisation in respect of the year satisfactory accounting records detailing the sources and nature of the income of the Organisation (including income from members) and the nature and purpose of expenditure; and
- (ii) the attached accounts and statements, prepared under the historical cost convention, and in accordance with Section 272 of the Workplace Relations Act 1996, as amended, are properly drawn up so as to give a true and fair view of:
  - (a) the financial affairs of the Organisation as at 31 December 2002; and
  - (b) the income and expenditure and surplus/deficit of the Organisation for the year ended on that date.
