Statement: Prescribed Information: Section 189(1) of the Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Act 2009

In accordance with Section 189 (1) of the of the Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Act 2009 and Regulation 138, I wish to lodge the following prescribed information in relation to an election for a casual vacancy for the position of Federal Executive member representing the New South Wales Branch of the AEU.

I am the Deputy Federal Secretary of the AEU and am authorised to lodge this prescribed information.

Name of Office:

One (1) Federal Executive Member representing the General Division of the NSW Branch.

Term of Office:

The person elected shall hold office until 29 February 2012.

Reason for the Election:

This election is required due to the resignation of John Irving from all positions associated with the AEU, due to his retirement. The resignation is attached.

Electorate

The electorate for this casual vacancy are members of the NSW Branch Council **who are assigned to the General Division** (Ref. AEU Federal Rule 35(1) (d)).

Date and Times:

Federal Rule 35 (6) (b) specifies that the processes for the conduct of the election should as far as is practicable be the same mode of election as prescribed in the relevant Federal Branch Rules by which the elections for the above casual vacancy for a Federal Executive Member position must be completed.

The AEU NSW Branch Federal Rule 12 (3) states that the Branch Returning Officer shall fix the place at which and the date on which the nominations close and the dates when the ballot shall be conducted if a ballot is necessary. It also outlines that nominations should be called for at least seven days prior to the date on which nominations close and at least thirty days before the date fixed for election.

The AEU NSW Branch Federal Rule 13 outlines additional processes and procedures for the conduct of this election. This rule outlines that the roll of voters is to be closed seven (7) days before the day on which nominations are opened for all elections by a direct voting system.

Voting System:

The voting system shall be a collegiate electorate system.
