As discussed by telephone this morning, the existing Council entitlements for Camden-Campbelltown, Canterbury-Bankstown, Cessnock, Illawarra, Manly-Warringah, Middle Harbour, Parramatta, Port Macquarie, Sutherland and TAFE Associations as shown in the table provided on 26/3/15 includes Branch Councillors representing the respective Associations as elected in E2013/257.

Balranald-Tooleybuc and Hay, Bega, and Murwillumbah Associations were created in accordance with the Organisation's rules. Balranald-Tooleybuc and Hay are a grouped association for the purpose of Council entitlement and in accordance with the rules at the cut-off date (11/4/2014) determined by the NSWTF Council had 91 financial members. Bega is an ungrouped association and at the cut-off had an entitlement to one councillor with 153 financial members. Murwillumbah is an ungrouped association and at the cut-off had an entitlement of one councillor with 189 financial members. The association groupings were determined by a decision of the NSWTF council on 31 May 2014 and therefore became the associations of the AEU-NSWTF branch as per rule 70 (9) (a) - (i) and (ii).

In each of the association groupings above, the councillor elected by the NSWTF was also a Branch Councillor of the AEU NSW branch. In the associations above Michael Sciffer for the grouped association of Balranald-Tooleybuc and Hay - as Michael is from Hay Association, Hay would have a nil entitlement to additional delegates but Balranald-Tooleybuc Association would have an entitlement to one additional delegate.
