109 - NOMINATIONS - BRANCH EXECUTIVE

(a) The Returning Officer shall call for nominations not later than 22nd July. The closing date for nominations shall be 5.00 p.m. on the 21st day of August;

110 - BALLOT - BRANCH EXECUTIVE
