Statement: Prescribed Information: Section 189(1) of the Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Act 2009

Electorate: The electorate is the financial members assigned to the TAFE Division of the Northern Territory Branch.

- (c) One (1) National TAFE Council Delegate.
1 January 2012 - 31 December 2013.

Electorate: The electorate is the financial members assigned to the TAFE Division of the Northern Territory Branch.

- (d) One (1) National Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Committee (TAFE Division) Member. *1 January 2012 - 31 December 2013.*

Electorate: The electorate is the financial members assigned to the TAFE Division of the Northern Territory Branch except that the member being nominated must be Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander members.

- (e) One (1) National Early Childhood Committee (General Division) Member.
1 January 2012 - 31 December 2013.

Electorate: The electorate is the financial members assigned to the General Division of the Northern Territory Branch except that the member being nominated must be an early childhood practitioner.

Reason for the Election

This election is required as a result of insufficient nominations being received for a number of positions in the recent election E2011/2614. I have attached a copy of the AEC declaration of results for your information.

Dates and Times

Federal Rule 30 (2) states: "Subject to the next sub-rule, the elections shall be conducted in accordance with a timetable which permits the declaration of the election **on or before 31 October** prior to the date on which the Federal Delegates assume office."

Federal Rules 74 and 76 are the relevant Rules for the election of the Aboriginal and Torres Islander Education Committee (TAFE division) and the National Early Childhood Committee members. The declaration of these elections must be **on or before 30 November** prior to the date the member takes office. Federal Branch Rules for the various branches contain respective timetables for the conduct of these elections.

Closure of the Roll of Voters

Federal Rule 30 (4) states that the roll of voters is to be closed seven days before the day on which nominations open.

Voting System

The voting system to be employed in the conduct of the elections for the offices is a direct voting system. Your attention is also drawn to the provisions of Rule 24(3A), Rule 25, Rule 47(3), Rule 47A and various Branch Rules concerning the minimum representation of women in connection with any ballots that are necessary for the election of Federal Conference Delegates from the General Division and the National TAFE Council.
