Schedule 1 - Workplace Relations Act 1996 (RAO Schedule)

I have received the financial report for the NT Branch of the Australian Education Union for the year ended 31 December 2005. The report was lodged on 9 February 2007. Further documents were received on 21 February 2007.

The documents have been filed and no further action is required with respect to the lodged documents.

However, the branch is required to make the following improvements to its financial documents in future financial years.

Special Purpose Financial Report

The Audit Report stated that the financial report was drawn up as a Special Purpose Financial Report (SPFR).

This approach is not consistent with the requirements of the RAO Schedule.

Section 253 expressly requires a General Purpose Financial Report (GPFR) to be prepared in accordance with the Australian Accounting Standards and it makes no provision for the use of an SPFR.

One of the reasons why an SPFR may not be used is because it involves the auditor disclaiming responsibility for the audit. There is a disclaimer of this kind in paragraph two of your audit report. This type of disclaimer is inconsistent with sections 253 and 257 of the RAO Schedule.

In the light of this, the NT Branch of the Australian Education Union is required in future years to prepare a full GPFR in accordance with s253 of the RAO Schedule and the Reporting Guidelines issued with respect to s253.

Seven steps to make a Financial Report

The lodged documents were not all done in the time frame required by the RAO Schedule.

Bear in mind that the financial report must always be completed and lodged in the Registry within $6\frac{1}{2}$ months of the end of the financial year – that is by 15 July.

If you take the following seven steps in strict chronological order you should be able to produce a financial report in future years without much difficulty:

- 1. After the financial year has ended prepare the following documents at a Committee Meeting:
 - (i) a <u>General Purpose Financial Report</u> that consists of :
 - Profit and Loss Statement,
 - Balance Sheet,
 - Statement of Cash Flows,
 - Notes to the Accounts as required by the Australian Accounting Standards (in addition, the Notes to the Accounts must quote verbatim s272(1) to (3) of the RAO Schedule),
 - <u>Committee of Management Statement</u> (this requires a resolution by the Committee see Items 24-26 of the Reporting Guidelines), and
 - (ii) an <u>Operating Report</u> (see s254 of the RAO Schedule and RAO Reg 159).
- 2. Then provide the General Purpose Financial Report to your Auditor.
- 3. The Auditor then prepares the <u>Auditor's Report</u> in accordance with s257 of the RAO Schedule. The *preferred* wording that should be used in this Report under s257(5) is:

In our/my opinion the general purpose financial report is presented fairly in accordance with applicable Australian Accounting Standards and the requirements imposed by Part 3 of Chapter 8 of Schedule 1 (RAO Schedule) of the Workplace Relations Act 1996.

The Report must then be signed and dated by the Auditor and include their qualification(s).

- 4. Then provide/email the full financial report to all members. The full financial report consists of:
 - (i) <u>General Purpose Financial Report</u> that consists of :
 - Profit and Loss Statement,
 - Balance Sheet,
 - Statement of Cash Flows,
 - Notes to the Accounts,
 - <u>Committee of Management Statement</u> (signed and dated by an elected officer),
 - (ii) <u>Operating Report</u> (signed and dated by an elected officer), and
 - (iii) <u>Auditor's Report</u> (signed and dated by the auditor)
- 5. Then present the full financial report to the next subsequent Committee meeting.
- 6. Then prepare a <u>Designated Officer's Certificate</u> under s268 that confirms that the full financial report has been provided to members and presented to the meeting.
- 7. Then lodge a copy of the full financial report and the Designated Officer's Certificate in the Industrial Registry within 14 days of the meeting.

Employee benefits paid to officers or employees

The Income and Expenditure Statement should separately disclose the employee benefits paid to:

- Holders of offices and
- Employees (other than holders of offices) see Item 11 of the Reporting Guidelines.

In the event that employee benefits are only paid to one category of persons (whether *holders of offices* or *employees*) then the accounts should clearly indicate which category that is.

Accurate dates

The lodged documents contained a number of incorrect dates as follows:

- the Committee of Management Statement stated that the financial year ended on 30 December 2005 rather than 31 December 2005,
- The Operating Report (for year ending 31 December 2005) stated that it was for year ending 31 December 2006.

In addition, the Designated Officer's Certificate did not state which financial year that it related to.

In future financial years please ensure that all of the financial documents have dates which are accurate.

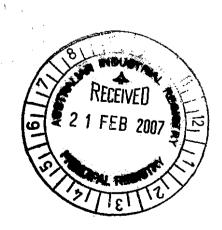

Notes to the Financial Statements

For the year ended 31 December 2005

Note 1: Statement of Significant Accounting Policies

This financial report is a special purpose financial report prepared in order to satisfy the financial reporting requirements of the Associations Incorporations Act. The committee has determined that the association is not a reporting entity.

The financial report has been prepared in accordance with the requirements of the Associations Incorporation Act and the following Australian Accounting Standards:

AAS 5: Materiality

AAS 8: Events Occurring After Reporting Date

No other Australian Accounting Standards, Urgent Issues Group Consensus Views or other authoritative pronouncements of the Australian Accounting Standards Board have been applied.

The financial report has been prepared on an accruals basis and is based on historic costs and does not take into account changing money values, or except where specifically stated, current valuations of non-current assets.

The following specific accounting policies, which are consistent with the previous period unless otherwise stated, have been adopted in the preparation of this financial report:

(a) Income tax

The association is exempt from income tax.

(b) Fixed Assets

Leasehold improvements and office equipment are carried at cost less, where applicable, any accumulated depreciation.

The depreciable amount of all fixed assets are depreciated over the useful lives of the assets to the association commencing from the time the asset is held ready for use. Leasehold improvements are amortised over the shorter of either the unexpired period of the lease or the estimated useful lives of the improvements.
