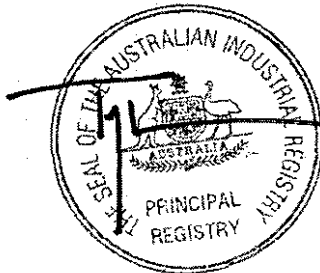
Arrangement for conduct of election.
