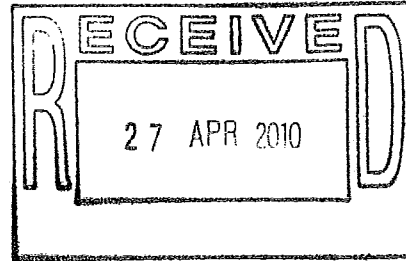

Queensland Federal Branch Rule 2(5) specifies the times and procedures for holding an election in the event there is a casual vacancy arising in the office of Branch Council.

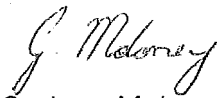
Electorate
