#### INDEPENDENT AUDIT REPORT

To the members of Australian Education Union (Queensland branch)

#### Scope

The Financial Report And The Committee of Management's Responsibility

The financial report comprises the balance sheet, income statement, statement of changes in accumulated funds and statement of cash flows and accompanying notes to the financial statements for Australian Education Union (Queensland branch) ("the branch") for the year ended 31 December 2006.

The members of the committee of management are responsible for preparing a financial report that gives a true and fair view of the financial position and performance of the branch, and that complies with Accounting Standards in Australia, in accordance with Part 3 of Chapter 8 of Schedule 1 (RAO Schedule) of the Workplace Relations Act 1996. #### Audit Approach

We performed procedures to assess whether in all material respects the financial report presents fairly, in accordance with Accounting Standards and other mandatory financial reporting requirements in Australia and the Workplace Relations Act 1996, a view which is consistent with our understanding of the branch's financial position, and of its performance as represented by the results of its operations, changes in accumulated funds and cash flows.

We formed our audit opinion on the basis of these procedures, which included:

#### NOTE 1 - ACCOUNTING POLICIES

#### (a) Basis of Accounting

The Balance Sheet and Income Statement are prepared on an accrual basis and are drawn up in accordance with the historical cost convention which requires that assets be carried in the Balance Sheet at or below the cost originally incurred at the date of acquisition. No adjustment is made for changes in the general purchasing power of the dollar or changes in the current price of specific assets.
