1. Name of Office

An election is required for each of the following offices:

2. Reason for the Elections

Elections for the offices identified in (I) and (II) are required because the terms of office will expire on 20 March 2011.

3. Number of Offices and Electorate

4. Date and Times

Federal Branch Rule 52(1A) requires the Roll of Voters to be closed seven days before the day on which nominations open.

6. Voting System

The voting system to be employed in the conduct of these elections is a direct voting system. The register of members is held at the Branch Office at 163 Greenhill Road, Parkside, South Australia.
