Statement: Prescribed Information: Section 189(1) of the Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Act 2009

In accordance with Section 189 (1) of the of the Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Act 2009 and Regulation 138, I wish to lodge the following prescribed information in relation to elections in the Tasmanian Branch of the Australian Education Union for the undermentioned office in this Union.

I am the Deputy Federal Secretary of the AEU and am authorised to lodge this prescribed information.

Name of Office:

One (1) member of the National TAFE Council AGM representing the Tasmanian Branch

Term of Office:

The person elected shall hold office until 31st December 2011.

Reason for the Election:

This election is required due to the resignation of Roberta Blackwood-Beattie from the position of National TAFE Council delegate. The resignation is attached. Please note that the resignation is dated 1 March 2010, however, due to an administrative oversight, the resignation was received by the Federal Office on the 4th October 2010 and hence the PI is being submitted now.

Federal Branch Rule 47 (7) is the rule that outlines the provision for filling casual vacancies on the National TAFE Council. As the resignation was tendered on 1 March 2010, it is our belief that an election is required.

Electorate

The electorate for this casual vacancy is the **financial members of the Tasmanian Branch who are assigned TAFE Division** (Ref. AEU Tasmanian Federal Branch Rule 29 (2) (a)).

Date and Times:

AEU Federal Rule 47 (7) establishes the procedures for filling a casual vacancy on the National TAFE Council.


AEU Tasmanian Federal Branch Rule 29 (2) (a) establishes the general provisions for the conduct of elections in the Branch. AEU Tasmanian Federal Branch Rule 30 (1A) states that the roll of voters is to be closed 7 days before the day on which nominations are opened in relation to all elections by a direct voting system for offices in the Branch.

Voting System:

The voting system shall be a direct voting system (ref Tasmanian Federal Branch Rule 29 (2) (a)).
