A prospective candidate had submitted a late nomination, mistakenly believing that the closing date for statements (7 October 2013) was the closing date for nominations. In fact all references to the closing date of nominations, in advertising and correspondence, did in fact refer to the correct closing date for nominations – of 30 September 2013.

The problem was caused by the size of the Election Notice and the fact that the closing date for nominations appeared overleaf on the second page.
