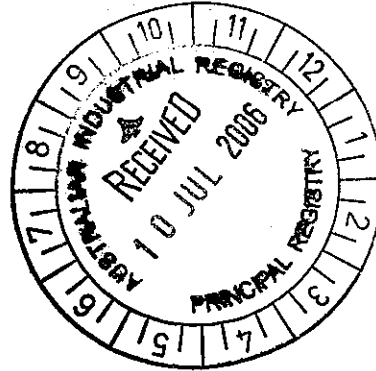


Voting System: The voting system to be employed in the conduct of the elections for the offices is a direct voting system.
