I, Brian John HENDERSON, Branch Secretary of the Australian Education Union Victorian Branch, am authorised to lodge the following prescribed information in relation to elections in the Australian Education Union Victorian Branch. The information is being lodged under subsection 189(1) of the RAO Schedule.

1. The offices and positions in respect of which an election is required are:

Ordinary members of Branch Executive from all sectors.

2. The reason for the elections:

Consistent with Rule 49 (1), ordinary members of Branch Executive take office on 1 January following their election and hold office for one year or until their successors take office. The term of the current ordinary members is due to expire on 31 December 2010.

3. The electorate:

- Six ordinary members of Branch Executive elected by and from all ordinary members of Primary Sector Council

8. Additional Information

Subject to Rule 11(3), the financial membership of the Branch at 30 June 2010 was 44,824.
