I, Brian John Henderson, Branch Secretary of the Australian Education Union Victorian Branch, am authorised to lodge the following prescribed information in relation to elections in the Australian Education Union Victorian Branch. The information is being lodged under subsection 189(1) of the RAO Schedule.

1. **The offices and positions in respect of which an election is required are:**  
**Delegates to Branch Conference, 2012.**
2. **The reason for the elections:**  
Consistent with Rule 51 (1), delegates to Branch Conference take office on the declaration of his/her election and hold office for one year or until his/her successor takes office.
3. **The electorates:**  
Rule 4 (1) sets out the various electorates:
  - (b) delegates elected by and from the financial members of the Early Childhood Sector in a region or group of regions;
  - (c) delegates elected by and from the financial members of the Primary Sector in each region;
  - (d) delegates elected by and from financial members of the Primary Allied Staff Sub-sector;
  - (e) delegates elected by and from the financial members of the Secondary Sector in each region;
  - (f) delegates elected by and from financial members of the Secondary Allied Staff Sub-sector;
  - (g) delegates elected by and from the financial members of the TAFE Colleges Sub-sector;

- (h) delegates elected by and from all financial members of the Disability Services Sub-sector;
- (i) delegates elected by and from all financial members of the Adult Migrant Education Service Sub-sector.

The attachments detail the calculation of delegate entitlements consistent with Rule 4 (2) and 4 (3).

**4. The dates and times for the opening and closing of nominations are:**

The dates and times for the opening and closing of nominations will be determined by the Returning Officer from the Australian Electoral Commission having regard to Rule 47 (5).

I would suggest the Returning Officer consider the following:

13 February 2012	Nominations open.
16 March 2012	Nominations close.
16 April 2012	If necessary, open ballots.
30 April 2012	Close ballots.

**5. Roll of voters shall close:**

In accordance with Rule 57 (2A), the roll of voters closes 7 days before the opening of nominations.

**6. Voting system:**

The voting system to be used in the conduct of the elections is direct election by and from the financial members of the relevant Sectors or Sub-sectors.


