**Re: Australian Education Union (W.A. Branch) Elections**

I am an officer of the *Australian Education Union (W.A. Branch)* and am authorised to sign this statement which is lodged in accordance with subsection 214 (1) of the Act.

In accordance with the requirements of the Rules of the Australian Education Union (Western Australian Branch), specifically Rules 2 (1) and 6 (1) (a) & (b), I request the Australian Industrial Relations Commission to instruct the Australian Electoral Commission to hold an election for positions which will become vacant pursuant to the constitution of the A.E.U.W.A.

This is the first tier of a two-tier election system and will require an election under Rule 2 (1) for the following offices:

***Thirty Four Branch Council Members***

From which elections will then need to be held under Rule 6 (1) (a) & (b) to elect:

- Branch President***
- Branch Deputy-President***
- Branch Secretary***
- Branch Deputy Secretary***
- Sixteen Branch Executive Members***

The reason for the election is that the incumbents' terms of office will expire on 19<sup>th</sup> January 2004. The voting system as Branch Councillors is by direct election.

The terms of office for the Branch Officers and sixteen Branch Executive Members ceases on 29<sup>th</sup> February 2004.

The electorates for the elections are:

- For the Branch Councillors under Rule 2 (1) – the full membership.
- For the Branch Executive Members and Branch Officers under Rule 6 (1) (a) & (b) – by and from Branch Council.

The dates and times that nominations close are to be fixed by the Returning Officer pursuant to the Rules.

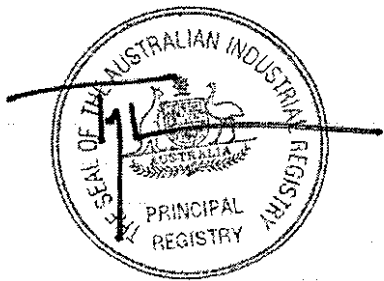


