

In accordance with the requirements of the Rules of the Australian Education Union (Western Australian Branch), specifically Rule 20. I request the Australian Industrial Relations Commission to instruct the Australian Electoral Commission to hold an election for positions which will become vacant pursuant to the constitution of the A.E.U.W.A.
