Reminder of actions required when persons elected to office

The Australian Electoral Commission has provided the Registered Organisations Commission (the ROC) a declaration of results for the election of uncontested offices in matter E2018/161. This letter is a reminder of certain obligations imposed on organisations and on persons elected to office.

A notice must be published on the organisation's website

The organisation or branch must, as soon as practicable after receiving the post-election report, publish on its website a notice that a copy of the report is available from the organisation, branch or the AEC on request. The notice must be kept on the website for a period of at least 3 months (see regulation 141 of the Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Regulations 2009).

Holders of office required to undertake approved training

Section 293K of the Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Act 2009 (the RO Act) requires each officer with financial management duties to undertake approved training that covers those duties within 6 months after the person begins to hold office. Please ensure that relevant officers undertake approved training within the required timeframe. Please also ensure that all new holders of office are advised of their obligations to make disclosures regarding remuneration, non-cash benefits and material personal interests, the details of which are provided for in the RO Act.

Organisation must notify the Commission of changes

Also, section 233(2) of the RO Act requires that an organisation must notify the Commission within 35 days of any changes to the holders of office in the organisation. If there are no changes a notification is not required. If the election has resulted in any changes to the holders of office, the Australian Education Union-Western Australia Branch must notify the Commission of these changes. In particular, please advise:


- 1. Person(s) who have ceased to hold office:
 - the name of the office vacated;
 - the date of the change of office holder; and
 - the name of the person vacating the office.
- 2. Person(s) who have commenced to hold office:
 - the name of the office now held;
 - the date of the change of office holder;
 - the name of the person now holding the office;

- the postal address of the person (generally the postal address of the organisation); and
- the occupation of the person now holding the office.

The notification must include a declaration by the Secretary (or other prescribed officer) that the information is a correct statement of the changes made. A template notification of changes, which may assist you, is attached. If any change does not apply until a date in the future, you do not need to notify until then (e.g. AGM, 1 January, 2nd Monday in March). If you have already lodged this information, please disregard this reminder.

Statement: Prescribed Information: Section 189(1) of the Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Act 2009

In accordance with Section 189 (1) of the Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Act 2009 and Regulation 138, I wish to lodge the following prescribed information in relation to elections in the Australian Education Union, Western Australian Branch, for the undermentioned offices.

I am an officer of the Australian Education Union (W.A. Branch) and am authorised to lodge this prescribed information.

Names of Offices:

Elections will need to be held under Rule 2(1)(b) to elect:

Members of Branch Council approximately 150:

20th March 2019 - 19th March 2020

Reason for the Elections:

The current term of office for the above positions expires on 19th March 2019.

The electorates for the elections are:

- Financial members whose place of work is within the same specified district as that of the elected delegates.
- The specified districts are as contained in Appendix B of the Federal Branch Rules SCHEDULE OF DISTRICTS as follows:
- 1. BELMONT- consisting of the state electorates of Bassendean, Belmont and Forrestfield.
- 2. BUNBURY consisting of the state electorates of Bunbury, Vasse and Collie-Preston.
- 3. BUTLER consisting of the state electorates of Burns Beach, Joondalup and Butler.

- 4. FREMANTLE consisting of the state electorates of Fremantle, Bicton and Willagee.
- 5. GOLDFIELDS consisting of the state electorates of Kalgoorlie, and Roe.
- 6. HILLARYS consisting of the state electorates of Wanneroo, Hillarys and Kingsley.
- 7. JANDAKOT consisting of the state electorates of Cockburn, Jandakot and Southern River.
- 8. KALAMUNDA consisting of the state electorates of Armadale, Darling Range and Kalamunda.
- KIMBERLEY- PILBARA- consisting of the state electorates of Kimberley, Pilbara and North-West Central.
- 10. MAYLANDS consisting of the state electorates of Maylands, Balcatta and Mount Lawley.
- 11. MOORE consisting of the state electorates of Geraldton, Moore and Central Wheatbelt.
- 12. MORLEY- consisting of the state electorates of Girrawheen, Mirrabooka and Morley.
- 13. MURRAY- consisting of the state electorates of Mandurah, Dawesville and Murray-Wellington.
- 14. PERTH consisting of the state electorates of Cottesloe, Nedlands and Perth.
- 15. RIVERTON consisting of the state electorates of Bateman, Riverton and Thornlie.
- 16. ROCKINGHAM consisting of the state electorates of Rockingham, Kwinana, Warnbro and Baldivis.
- 17. SCARBOROUGH consisting of the state electorates of Churchlands, Scarborough and Carine.
- 18. STIRLING consisting of the state electorates of Albany and Warren-Blackwood.
- 19. SWAN consisting of the state electorates of West Swan, Swan Hills and Midland.
- 20. VICTORIA PARK consisting of the state electorates of South Perth, Victoria Park and Cannington.

The number of Branch Council members for each district shall be determined in accordance with Federal Branch Rule 2(1)(b).

The voting system is by direct election. Under Rule 13 (9A), the roll of voters for any election is to be closed seven days before the day on which nominations are opened. Under Rule 9(8), nominations for election to Branch Council shall be called at least fourteen days prior to the date on which nominations close.

The dates and times that nominations close are to be fixed by the Returning Officer pursuant to the Rules.
