I acknowledge receipt of the Prescribed Information (PI) of the Australian Federation of Air Pilots (AFAP) for the election of the offices of President, Vice-President (Administration and Finance), Vice-President (Membership), Trustee and Technical Director. The PI was lodged with Fair Work Australia on 27 May 2010 and a decision issued on 24 June 2010. Please find attached a copy of the decision. This letter offers advice and comments regarding prescribed information for future elections and also requests the immediate lodgement of PI for Branch and Council elections.

1. Day on which roll of voters is to be closed

Regulation 138(1)(f) of the Fair Work (Registered Organisation) Regulations 2009 requires the PI to state the day on which the roll of voters is closed. Rule 12(6)(c) of the AFAP rules provides that the roll of voters is updated so as to include all financial members on the fourteenth day prior to opening of nominations. This should be included in future PIs.

2. Relevant legislation

The PI lodged refers to Schedule 1 of the Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Act 2009. Please note that the relevant provisions are not contained within a schedule to the Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Act 2009. 3. Timeline requirements for lodgement of Prescribed Information

I write to emphasis the timeline requirements for the lodgment of Prescribed Information. Section 189(2) of the Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Act 2009 requires the lodgment before the prescribed day (or such later day as the General Manager allows). Regulation 138(3) defines the prescribed day as the day occurring two months before the first day when a person may become a candidate in the election. Also the Federation's rules state that in relation to the election for Branch and Council Committees and Officers '[A]n election request will be made to the relevant authority around two months prior to this declaration' and that nominations open on or around 15 July (rule 12(3)(a)).

Your correspondence states that the paperwork for this offices will be provided before COB 8 July 2010. However this does not meet the requirements of the Act and its regulations. The PI should have been lodged in mid-May and is significantly overdue. Please attend to the lodgement of the PI as a matter of urgency.
