Section 197(1) of Schedule 1 of the Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Act 2009 requires the AEC to provide a written report on the conduct of the election to Fair Work Australia and to the organisation or branch for whom the election was conducted. Rules difficult to apply/interpret:	Rule 12(3)(i) states "Within 7 days of the close of nominations the Returning Officer shall issue an envelope" which identifies when the ballot shall open. This rule cannot be complied with as it is in direct conflict of Rules 12(3)(b)(iii) and 12(3)(b)(iv)(1) which allows for remedying defective nominations "within not less than seven days after him being notified" and withdrawal of nominations "not later than 7 days after the close of nominations," respectively. As these conflict, could one please be changed to ensure consistency?
Model Rule reference (if any):	Also, rule 12(5)(b) states that "Nominations shall be called by the Returning Officer by notice <u>posted</u> by him to each member of the Federation eligible to vote under these Rules" (emphasis added). As the number of members has now exceeded 3000 this is a very highly impractical advertising method. It is suggested that this is changed to allow for email, website and/or advertising in a publication of the organisation instead. N/A
