Re: AEC Post Election Report E2021/60 – Federal Elections – Australian Federation of Air Pilots ("AFAP") Response

We refer to the AEC's Post Election report of 15 October 2021 referencing the following rule deemed difficult to apply or interpret. Please find the AFAP's response below.

Rule identified by the AEC as difficult to apply/interpret:

'12.6(d) Within 14 days of the close of nominations the Returning Officer shall issue to each member who is eligible to vote, by prepaid post an envelope which shall contain:

- (i) a ballot paper prepared in accordance with these Rules;
- (ii) a declaration envelope and an envelope by which the member may return the ballot paper by post without expense to the voter, provided such envelopes shall be in the form prescribed in the appropriate Act and Regulations.
- (iii) any other document required for the conduct of the election as determined by the Returning Officer.

Procedural defect – There is insufficient time between the close of nominations and the opening of the ballot, to allow for the periods required for the withdrawal nominations and defective nominations period, and the preparation of the ballot material (including candidate statements) to be posted to all members of the organisation.

It is suggested that an appropriate period between that close of nominations and the opening of the ballot would be 28 days.'

AFAP Response:

The AFAP Rules may only be amended by resolution of the AFAP Convention. The next Convention is scheduled to take place on 7 October 2022. At this Convention delegates will be asked to approve an alteration to sub-rule 12(6)(d) to extend the timeframe for issuing ballot materials for federal elections.

Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Act 2009 s.189—Arrangement for conduct of an election

Australian Federation of Air Pilots (E2021/60)

Arrangement for conduct of election.

[1] On 21 April 2021, the Australian Federation of Air Pilots (the organisation) lodged with the Registered Organisations Commission prescribed information for an election to fill the following offices:

Vice President (Administrative and Finance)

Trustee

Welfare Director

[2] I note that on 31 January 2020, the organisation lodged prescribed information for an election **E2020/41** seeking to fill casual vacancy in the office of Welfare Director, and that on 6 March 2020, a Delegate of the Commissioner arranged for an election of this office in **E2020/41** (Decision [2020] ROCD 28).

[3] Due to the delay in the conduct of elections by the Australian Electoral Commission (AEC) as a result of the COVID-19 pandemic, election E2020/41 was among the elections deferred. It has not yet been conducted.

[4] The same office of Welfare Director (the subject of the Delegate's decision in **E2020/41**) is now part of the prescribed information lodged on 21 April 2021 in this matter (**E2021/60**) as part of a scheduled election in accordance with the organisation's rules.

[5] There is therefore the potential for the two elections, E2020/41 and E2021/60, to occur simultaneously or in close proximity to each other with the office of Welfare Director being required to be filled in both elections. It is clear that the conduct of the two elections at the same time and for the same office would be a duplication of the required election.

[6] I am satisfied that an election for the abovenamed offices is required to be held under the rules of the organisation and, under subsection 189(3) of the *Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Act 2009*, I am making arrangements for the conduct of the election by the AEC.

[7] However, the AEC is only required to conduct one election for the office of Welfare Officer and if the AEC were to now conduct the election for E2021/60 this would satisfy the requirement to conduct the election sought in the matter E2020/41.
