(a) Name of each office for which election is required:

(b) Reasons for election:

Elections for these offices is required to be conducted annually (see Rules 14, 15 and 16).

The term of each current office will expire, in the normal course, at its meeting to be conducted on 3 October 2005.

(c) The number of offices to be filled:

Four (4) (noting the deletion of the previous offices of Trustees by recent Rule amendments)

(d) Date and time of commencement and expiration of period for calling of nominations:

Either at the first meeting of the National Board following its election – Rule 15(b), or pursuant to Rule 16 in the case of a secret posted ballot.

(e) The day provided in the Rules of the Organisation as the day on which the roll of voters is to close:

Not provided in the Rules, but see Rules 15 and 16 (collegiate election, not direct voting system)

(f) Method of election

**Collegiate voting system;**

**and either:**

**secret ballot pursuant to Rule 15(b) or Secret postal ballot  
pursuant to Rule 16, as the case may be.**
