ALLEGATIONS OF IRREGULARITIES RECEIVED

There were no written complaints or allegations of irregularities.

IRREGULARITIES IDENTIFIED

Irregularity

1. Procedural irregularity: Failure to comply with prescribed nominations open and close dates.

Details

Branch Rule 15(2) stipulates that elections for Divisional Representatives to the Board (i.e. Stage 1) shall be conducted in accordance with National Rule11 (*mutatis mutandis*). National Rule 11 (e) stipulates that each Branch Committee of the Association shall at its 1st meeting following its election appoint a Returning Officerand such Returning Officer shall at least 14 days prior to the 1st of April in each year call for nominations for the Branch's Representative(s) to the National Board by circular to each member of the Branch Committee of Management.

ACTION TAKEN IN RELATION TO IRREGULARITIES

1. The Decision pertaining to this election was received by the AEC on 22 April 2004 [i.e. issued by the Australian Industrial Registry]. As the prescribed nomination dates had already passed, action was taken under Section 193 (1) (b) of Schedule 1B of the Workplace Relations Act 1996 to ensure that the elections was carried out as soon as possible. As Returning Officer, I therefore set the nominations opening date at 30 April 2004, and closing date at 14 May 2004 (12pm).

OTHER MATTERS

1.

The organisation **did submit** the prescribed information for both Stage 1 & Stage 2 of the ACT Branch elections at the same lodgement time to the AIR, so that both stages were covered under one Decision.

However, theoretically, the timetable for Stage 1 annually works out to be: Nominations open on 17 March in that year & nominations close on 1 April in that year.

Knowing that nominations open on 17 March, the AHA-ACT Branch **should preferably submit** the necessary prescribed information (relating to this election) to the AIR on 17 January that is, 2 months prior to nominations opening. [Note: this is a requirement under Section 189(1) and Regulation 138(3) of Schedule 1B of the Workplace Relations Act 1996.]

2.

In regards to *Branch Representative(s) to the National Board*, Branch Rule 26 – does not specify which particular National Rule to apply. Assuming National Rule 11 applies, the election of the *Branch Representative(s) to the National Board* should be conducted as a postal ballot [if contested – National Rule 11(g)]. Similarly, In regards to *Branch Representative to the National Accommodation Division*, Branch Rule 26 – does not specify which particular National Rule to apply. Assuming National Rule 42 (c) applies, the election of the *Branch Representative to the National Accommodation Division* should be conducted as per National Rule 16 (by postal ballot).

However, over the past 4 years, the elections for all these offices were conducted at the same time as the elections for the Executive [i.e. President, Vice-President & Secretary/Treasurer] – under National Rule 15, at the first ACT Branch meeting (as a collegiate attendance ballot), as a matter of expediency – as all ACT Board Members were present.

This, however, is not in accordance with the AHA Rules, as National Rule 11 clearly stipulates that the elections for the *Branch Representative(s) to the National Board* should be conducted as a postal ballot, and the elections for the *Branch Representative to the National Accommodation Division* should also be conducted by postal ballot (National Rule 42(c) and National Rule 16).

With the elections for the Executive, there is a choice between opting for either a collegiate attendance ballot or having a postal ballot. Branch Rule 15 (3) stipulates that the elections for the Executive [i.e. President, Vice-President & Secretary/Treasurer] shall be conducted in accordance with National Rule 15 [i.e. at the first ACT Branch meeting, as a collegiate attendance ballot], National Rule 16 & 17 [i.e. as a postal ballot].
