Australian Hotels Association – ACT Branch Post Election Report - Scheduled Election E2012/284

I refer to the above election for your organisation.

Section 197(1) of the Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Act 2009 requires the AEC to provide a written report on the conduct of the election to FWA and to the organisation or branch for whom the election was conducted. A copy of the report in relation to this election is attached.

Section 198 of the Act requires that if an organisation or branch is given a post-election report under section 197 that identifies a rule that was difficult to interpret or apply, the organisation or branch must, within 30 days, give a written response to the AEC on that aspect of the report. Further, Regulation 141(4) of the Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Regulations 2009 requires an organisation or branch to publish a notice on its web site advising members that a copy of the post-election report is available upon request. If a website is not available, publishing a notice in a journal or newsletter would be considered appropriate.

Arrangement for conduct of election.

Positions for which elections are required

- Ginninderra One representative to the Branch Board
- Brindabella One representative to the Branch Board
- Molonglo Four representatives to the Branch Board
- Accommodation Hotels Two representatives to the Branch Board
- Accommodation Hotels Representative to the AHA National Accommodation Hotels Division

Under Rule 15(2)(c)(i), if a Division is entitled to one representative, the elected representative shall also be known as the President of that Division.

Under Rule 15(2)(c)(ii), if a Division is entitled to two or more representatives and:

- a) there is a ballot, the representative with the most votes shall be known as the Divisional President and the representative with the second largest number of votes shall be known as the Vice-President; or
- b) the number of representatives do not exceed the number of representatives to be elected, the first nominated Divisional Representative shall be known as the Divisional President and the second nominated representative shall be known as the Divisional Vice-President.

The reason for the election is that the terms are due to expire under the normal course of events under the rules of the organisation.

The electorate for the direct voting systems representatives from each division to the Branch Board are the members of that division.

The electorate for the Direct Voting System for Representative to the National Accommodation Hotels Division is the members from the AHA ACT Accommodation Hotels Division.

It is proposed that nominations for Stage One Elections will open on Monday 4 June 2012 and close on Monday 18 June 2012, providing the minimum 14 days as required by AHA National Rule 16.
