Dear Mr Ryan

I acknowledge receipt of the prescribed information (PI) regarding the 2010 elections for the New South Branch delegates to the National Board of the Australian Hotels Association and for the New South Wales Branch representatives to the National Accommodation Hotels Division. The documents were lodged with Fair Work Australia on 5 March 2010 and a decision issued and forwarded to the AEC on 15 March 2010. Please find attached a copy of the decision.

As discussed earlier to today, I write to emphasis the timeline requirements for the lodgment of PIs. Section 189(2) of the Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Act 2009 (the RO Act) requires the lodgement before the prescribed day (or such later day as the General Manager allows). Regulation 138(3) defines the prescribed day as the day occurring two months before the first day when a person may become a candidate in the election. I note that rule 11(e) of the AHA national rules state that nominations for delegates to National Board open at least 14 days before the 1 April in each year. According to my calculations this means the PI for delegates to National Board must be lodged with FWA no later than 17 January in each year. I note that this office has advised the Branch previously of this requirement. In future years please ensure that lodgment occurs at least 2 months prior to the first day when a person may become a candidate in the election.

Also further to our conversation today, I write to offer the following comments for your consideration. If you have any queries I can be contacted on 03 8661 7929 on or after 22 March 2010.

1. Electorate for delegates to National Board and for representatives to National Accommodation Hotels Division

Regulation 138(1)(d) requires the PI to disclose the electorate for an election comprised only of members of a branch, section or other division. Rules 11(f) and (g) of the national rules provide that delegates to National Board are elected by and from the Branch Committee. Rule 42(c) of the national rules providse that the electorate for representatives to National Accommodation Hotels Division is the members of the branch's Accommodation Hotels Division. Please ensure the electorates are specified in future PIs.

2. Date that nominations close for delegates to National Board

Regulation 138(1)(e) requires the PI to specify the date of the beginning and end (my emphasis) of the period in which nominations will be called for. The PI lodged with FWA for the election to

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National Board does not state the end of the period, which I understand to be from rule 11(f) of the national rules, 1 April. Please ensure this is included in future Pls.

3. Date that nominations open and close for representatives to National Accommodation Hotels Division

The PI lodged with FWA for representatives to National Accommodation Hotels Division refers to rules 42(c) and rule 16 of the national rules, which I agree are the relevant rules. However it appears that the rules do not provide for opening of nominations for these representatives. If you agree that the rules do not specify a date for the opening of nominations, then that should be stated in the PI. It is my understanding that rule 16(a) provides that nominations for these representatives close not less than 14 days and no more than 30 days after nominations open. If you agree, then this should be stated in the PI.

4. Date that the roll of voters closes for delegates to National Board

Regulation 138(1)(f) provides that the PI is to state the day on which the roll of voters is to close. The PI lodge with FWA for delegates to National Board states that the roll closes seven days before the nominations open in accordance with rule 11(e). However rule 11(e) pertains to elections with direct voting systems only. As this is a collegiate election this provision is not relevant. If you agree with this interpretation please ensure that the PI states that the rules do not provide for a date that the roll of voters is to close because it is collegiate election.
