Reminder of actions required when persons elected to office

The Australian Electoral Commission has provided the Fair Work Commission (the Commission) a declaration of results for the election [E2015/278]. This letter is a reminder of certain obligations imposed on organisations and persons elected to office.

Section 154D(1) of the *Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Act 2009* (the RO Act) requires the rules of organisations (and branches of organisations) to require each officer with financial management duties to undertake approved training that covers those duties within 6 months after the person begins to hold office. Please ensure that relevant officers undertake approved training within the required timeframe.

Please also ensure that all new holders of office are advised of their obligations to make disclosures regarding remuneration, non-cash benefits and material personal interests, the details of which should be provided for in your organisation's rules.

Also, section 233(2) of the RO Act requires that an organisation must notify the Commission within 35 days of any changes to the holders of office in the organisation. If there are no changes a notification is not required. If the election has resulted in any changes to the holders of office, the Australian Hotels Association-New South Wales Branch must notify the Commission of these changes. In particular, please advise:

- 1. Person(s) who have ceased to hold office:
 - the name of the office vacated;
 - the date of the change of office holder; and
 - the name of the person vacating the office.
- 2. Person(s) who have commenced to hold office:
 - the name of the office now held;
 - the date of the change of office holder;
 - the name of the person now holding the office;
 - the postal address of the person (generally the postal address of the organisation); and
 - the occupation of the person now holding the office.

The notification must include a declaration by the Secretary (or other prescribed officer) that the information is a correct statement of the changes made. I have attached a template notification of changes which may assist you. If any change does not apply until a specific date, you don't need to notify until then (e.g. AGM, 1 January, 2nd Monday in March). If you have already lodged this information, please disregard this reminder.

Good afternoon

I refer to the above election for your organisation.

Section 197(1) of the Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Act 2009 ("the Act") requires the AEC to provide a written report on the conduct of the election to the Fair Work Commission and to the organisation or branch for whom the election was conducted. A copy of the report in relation to this election is attached.

Section 198 of the Act requires that if an organisation or branch is given a Post-Election Report under Section 197 that identifies a rule that was difficult to interpret or apply, the organisation or branch must, within 30 days, give a written response to the AEC on that aspect of the report. The response must specify whether the organisation or branch intends to take any action in relation to the rule, and if so, what action it intends to take.

In accordance with subsection 189(3) of the Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Act 2009 the General Manager of Fair Work Commission makes arrangements for the conduct of this election by the Australian Electoral Commission [an AEC Returning Officer is then appointed to conduct the

election.]

Rule 11(e) RO call for nominations 14 days prior to first day of April – As the election of the NSW Branch Committee which forms the collegiate from which the Board representatives are elected was not completed by the first day of April not possible to adhere to this date. Although Rule 11 (f) refers to the receipt of nomination forms on or before the first day of April (or such later time as allowed by the RO). This rule would appear to allow the RO to extend/change the nomination receipt period but does not address the issue of calling nominations 14 days prior to the first day of April as stated in 11 (e).

Rule 11 (f) Nominations not received at the registered office of the Branchshall be disregarded This rule prohibits nominations being returned directly to the office of the AEC Returning Officer by hand, post, email or facsimile and may therefore casue an irregularity in the election.

Rule 11 (iv) Return of ballot paper not earlier than 3 days nor later than 14 days after posting – the change to postal delivery times by Australia Post particularly to non-metro areas may result in members not having adequate time to receive and return ballot material within 14 days.

Rule 16 (c) ...nominations may be handed or posted. This rule appears to preclude nomination forms being received electronically by email or facsimile.

Rule 16 (c) (3) ...closing date for ballot papers within 14 days after posting. The change to postal delivery times by Australia Post particularly to non-metro areas may result in members not having adequate time to receive and return ballot material within 14 days.
