- Delegates of the Australian Hotels Association, New South Wales Branch, to the National Board of the National Organisation.

(b) Reasons for election:

- Election is required to be conducted annually (see Rule 11 (aa) of the Rules of the Australian Hotels Association);
- The term of each current office is due to expire in the normal course, in the normal course of events at the Annual meeting of the Board in 2017.

(c) The number of offices to be filled:

- Eight (8) (See Rule 11(aa)(A) (8) and Rule 11 (aa) (CA) of the Rules of the Australian Hotels Association);
- Note: One of these offices is filled by the President of the Branch ex officio – (See Rule 11 (aa) (D) of the Rules of the Australian Hotels Association).

(d) The name of the branch, section or division to which the election relates:


- The Branch Committee of Management of the New South Wales Branch of the Australian Hotels Association (See Rule 11 (f) of the Rules of the Australian Hotels Association).


(e) Date and time of commencement and expiration of the period for calling of nominations:

- The commencement of the period for calling nominations is at least 14 days prior to the first day of April (See Rule 11 (e) of the Rules of the Australian Hotels Association);
 - The expiration of the period for calling of nominations is 1 April (See Rule 11 (f) of the Rules of the Australian Hotels Association).
- (f) The day provided in the Rules of the Organisation as the day on which the roll of voters is to close:
- Seven (7) days before the day upon which nominations for the election open – (See Rule 11 (e) of the Rules of the Australian Hotels Association).
- (g) Method of election

- Representative of the Australian Hotels Association, New South Wales Branch to the National Accommodation Hotels Division of the Australian Hotels Association.

(b) Reasons for election:

- Election is required to be conducted annually (see Rule 42 (c) of the Rules of the Australian Hotels Association).
- The term of each current office will expire in the normal course.

(c) The number of offices to be filled:

- Two (2).

(d) The name of the branch, section or other division to which the election relates:

- The Accommodation Division of the New South Wales Branch of the Australian Hotels Association.

(e) Date and time of commencement and expiration of period for calling of nominations:

- The Rules do not specify a date for the opening of nominations.
- However, nominations shall close not less than fourteen (14) days nor more than thirty (30) days after the last nomination form

is posted (See Rule 42 (c) and Rule 16 (a) of the Rules of the Australian Hotels Association).

(f) The day provided in the Rules of the Organisation as the day on which the roll of voters is to close:


- Seven (7) days before the day upon which nominations for the election open – see Rule 42 (c) of the Rules of the Australian Hotels Association.


(g) Method of election
