

- [2] Subsection 182(1) of the *Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Act 2009* requires the Australian Electoral Commission to conduct an election for each office in an organisation or branch of an organisation unless an exemption has been granted under section 182(2). No such exemption has been granted to the Queensland Branch. Nor have exemptions been granted in relation to the relevant federal offices.
- [3] Elections for the above offices are significantly overdue. Arrangements for the conduct of an election for the above offices, except for the Representatives to the National Accommodation Hotels Division were last made in 2001. Arrangements for the conduct of an election for the Representatives to the National Accommodation Hotels Division were last made in 2005. The terms of office for the requested offices are either 12 months or 2 years. As a result the prescribed information should have been lodged and was not lodged within the prescribed periods on a number of occasions. By failing to lodge prescribed information in relation to an election an organisation or a branch contravenes a civil penalty provision.
- [4] The Branch was informed that the prescribed information was not lodged before the day prescribed by Regulation 138(3) of the *Fair Work (Registered Organisations)* Regulations 2009. That day is the day occurring 2 months before the first day when a person may, under the rules of the organisation or branch, become a candidate in the election. The Branch advised me that the reason for elections not being conducted at the scheduled time is that the Branch could not attract sufficient numbers of nominations to fill the Branch offices. The Branch has acknowledged the extended delay and provided an explanation for the delay. While I accept that the Branch may have experienced difficulty in attracting sufficient nominations, the Branch nonetheless was obligated under section 189(1) of the *Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Act 2009* to lodge the prescribed information in relation to elections for its offices to be conducted by the Australian Electoral Commission. The fact that elections have not been held for a considerable period of time does not obviate the need for an election. I do not want to frustrate the democratic function of the Branch and therefore I allow lodgement on 15 March 2013 in the present circumstance.
- [5] I am satisfied under these circumstances that an election for the abovenamed offices is required to be held under the rules of the organisation and, under subsection 189(3) of the Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Act 2009, I am making arrangements for the conduct of the election by the Australian Electoral Commission.

[6] Although arrangements are being made for the conduct of an election for the above offices this does not excuse the non-lodgement of the prescribed information for those offices within the prescribed periods nor does it exclude the possibility of action being undertaken under section 305 of the *Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Act 2009*.

I refer to my earlier letters of 14 March, 28 August and 29 October 3013 on the subject of Branch elections for the Australian Hotels Association (Queensland Branch). The latter two letters cover the submission of Prescribed Information in support of a request for elections to be held in 2013/2014 by the Australian Hotels Association (Queensland Branch).

Elections for the Branch are outstanding and overdue, and the proposed election is intended as a precursor to the approval of new rules for the branch.

The reasons for the extended delay in the submission of the Prescribed Information are as follows:

- Following completion of the most recent Branch elections in 2002 2003, the Australian Electoral Commission (AEC) reported on a number of anomalies with the conduct of that election and the functionality of the rules of the Branch which would require remedial action prior to future elections being held.
- Put simply, the AHA (Qld Branch) had been attempting to conduct elections for an organisational structure which was unsustainable and which, in fact, no longer existed. This comprised (from the ground up): 23 separate (electoral) Divisions, each being required under the Rules to elect up to nine members of a Divisional Management Committee. The objective of Branch elections under the existing rules is to elect up to 203 separate delegates at Divisional level which then form the 'college' from which the higher management committees are elected in subsequent internal elections.
- Structural, ownership, and geographical changes in the Queensland hotel industry over the last 40 years means that it is practically impossible to 'man' the electoral structure that exists under the existing Branch Rules. Corporate ownership, the progressive closure of country hotels, improved

communications by Internet, and the advent of absentee hotel owners and professional managers of hotels, means that there is not sufficient interest in nominating for and meeting the obligations of elected office at Division level to provide effective governance at this lowest level within the structure.

- The approach of the AHA (Qld Branch) to this situation was to review and modernize its structure to account for the revised nature of the hotel industry, with a view to streamlining its organizational and electoral structures. These revised structures, including a simplified electoral and governance structure, have been reflected in revised (draft) Branch Rules which have been developed in consultation with, and with the assistance of, RO Branch, FWC.
- The above process gave rise to a 'chicken and egg' situation with regards to overdue Branch elections, that is, it was somewhat pointless commissioning elections under the old Rules that were likely to fail, but that elections could not be called under new rules until such times as those rules were approved by a legitimately elected Branch Board.
- In order to break this deadlock, it was agreed in principle between FWC and the AHA (Qld Branch) in 2012 that the most sensible and pragmatic course of action was to proceed to call AHA (Qld Branch) elections under the existing Rules and, were those elections to fail, this would represent the required trigger for an application to be made to the Federal Court for relevant orders to be made to enable an interim State Board to be appointed. This interim Board could then act to approve the revised and simplified Branch Rules referred to above. This outcome would, in turn, provide the circumstances for elections to be held under new, simplified rules (dissolving the Divisional structure), with direct election of a new State Board.

Throughout this extended period of time, officers and staff of the Branch have acted in good faith with the Fair Work Commission, taking iterative and progressive administrative steps to bring about a resolution to the dilemma facing the Branch, that is, a dated and unworkable theoretical organizational structure which has outlived its usefulness and created a barrier to the conduct of elections with its rules. The Branch therefore seeks the support of the Delegate in offering support to the intended course of action, including approval of the previously submitted Prescribed Information, and assistance with ongoing action to finalise and implement revised and simplified Rules for the Branch.
